Translation & Localization: We have adopted a 3-step process of Translation , Editing and Proofreading (TEP) so that each project is viewed by three different sets of eyes, to ensure consistent quality on each and every project. Moreover, in case of certain projects, we implement the additional step of back translation: Back Translation is defined as translation of the new language version back into the original language. Translators should be native of the source language and the translation should be on the literal side as it is to convey the meaning of the translation. The translator should not have access to the original source document. The back translation is not be for publishing but is required by the FDA (USA) for certain documents, especially the Patient Consent Forms (ICF).

Desktop Publishing & Graphics: Our graphic designers take care of all the formatting to ensure that the layout of your translated document stays true to the source format. Our DTP teams can handle a large number of publishing formats (FrameMaker, PageMaker, InDesign, Adobe Photoshop and more) and platforms (PC and Mac). They are experts in the generation of final copy or camera-ready deliverables.

Quality Assurance & Evaluation: This is the final step in the translation or localization process, to ensure the quality of the content of your document. We use only native speakers of the target language for each individual project.
